Tisdag 9/8 - Ankomst Tallinn ankomst i Tallinn vid 10-12.30. Upphämtning vid flyplatsen och ex vid Järnvägstation centralt i stan, färd mot Dagö och Kärdla, inkvartering och ev. kort besök i familjens Bisas gård innan middagen vid Rannapargu.

10/8 - Utflykt till södra Dagö; stopp för picknick-proviantering i Käina, Kassari kapell och museum udden Sääre tirp. Återfärd via Spinnerifabriken vid Kassari, slottet Suuremõisa, middag i Mihkli i Malmas by på kvällen med rökbastu.

11/8: Släktutflyktsdag; Takne udde och militärmuséet, byarna Muddas, Ogandi och Koidma (korta stopp), Rootsi och Röicks kyrka, Pihla prästgård och lunch/middag vid Viinaköök i Hohenholm samt Köpu fyr torn mot kvällen. Återfärd mot Kärdla.

Lördag 12/8: Relativt tidig frukost och återfärd mot Tallinn, ev. via Padis kloster. Ankomst i Tallinn senast 12.00.

### Måltiderna på resan är tänkta så här:

9/8: frukost på egen hand i Tallinn, sen lunch på båten över till Dagö, middag 19.30 på Strandparken (Rannapaargu) - alla betalar var för sig.

10/8: frukost på Paadu, inköp för egen pick-nick på södra Dagö (eget handlande), middag på Mickelsgården (öl, vatten, bröd, smör, ost, rökt skinka och rökta näbbgäddor mm).

11/8: frukost på Paadu, buffetlunch på Viinaköök i Hohenholm 14.00 (betalas själv), kaffe/öl smörgås mm vid Köpu fyr torn på em och middag på egen hand i Kärdla på kvällen.

12/8: tidig frukost (avfärd ca 06.00) på Paadu, kaffe/lättlunch på båten över till fastlandet och ev. kaffe i Keila eller Padise på egen hand.

## **Visiting Dagö/Hiiumaa with a group of Hiiuswedish descendants in August 2015**

To have roots is an important thing to many people today; to know yourself through understanding your fore-fathers and mothers is a way to begin to understand who you really are.

On a trip on August 12-15 a group of 28 Swedes with their roots in Gammalsvenskby in the Ukraine (1782-1929) and on Hiiumaa (1250?-1781) was visiting the home island of their kin.

The former Swedish village of Kärrdal (Kärdla) with the home of the family Bisa (Pisa) was one stop on this journey. The lighthouse of Takne (Tahkuna) with the wonderful view over the peninsula with all the former minor Swedish villages another.

But the highlights were the stops in the former Swedish villages: one for the Martis family with their roots in Kausta (Kauste), the next in Muddas and Åkernäs (Muddaste and Ogandi) where the Knutas family came from, another in Koidma - home for the Hinas family, one stop at Buskas grinde (Puski värav) in Buskbien situated between Rootsi and Pihla Haava for the Buskas and Hoas (branch 2) families, one stop in Röicks where the Annas and Hoas (branch 1) lived between what today is Rootsi and Reigi and the last in Utanbien (the outer village) between Rootsi and Kabul nina where the family Utas had it's home. A visit to Reigi church and a chance to sing some hymns there completed this part of the trip.

Everybody gave their expression of what it meant to have these memories added to their knowledge of the destiny of their fore-fathers and through that a new feeling for themselves and who they really are.

Visiting different museums, Köpu lighthouse, Hiiu will (Spinning comapnay), Kassari with it's chapel and the wonderful Sääre tirp made this trip a real memory for life to this group.
